## **Agatha the Little Witch Amigurumi**

Little Explorer Series

Crochet Pattern





### Start Here...

- Please, read the whole pattern through properly so you have a good overview.
- This amigurumi is made up of the following parts:
  - 1 Head with 2 Ears, Nose, 2 Eyes and Hair.
  - 2 Arms
  - 2 Feet and 1 Body with Skirt
  - 1 Witch Hat with Buckle
- Measurements (without hat): 11 inches (28 cm).

### Materials

- 3 mm crochet hook (*only for Eyes*).
- 4 mm crochet hook
- 5 mm crochet hook (*only for hair and witch hat*).
- Worsted Weight Yarn: Beige (60 gr), Fuchsia (50 gr), Orange (45 gr), Dark Red (120 gr) and Black (110 gr).
- DK Yarn: White (*just a little*).
- Thread: Black (*just a little*).
- Cushion Stuffing.
- 2 Amigurumi Safety Eyes 21mm.
- Scissors & needle.

### Notes

- The ch and sl st are not included in the stitch count of each round.
- Note that the orientation of all parts of the pattern are set looking at the project from the front.

## Special Stitches

### Picot

- 3 ch and 1 sl st in first ch.

## Generic Processes

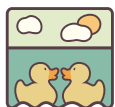
### Sew Edges

It's an easy process. Just take your piece, flatten it, and sew the open edges closed. Depending on the pattern, you should fasten off or leave a long tail to sew it later.



### Glossary:

**sc:** single crochet || **ch:** chain || **sl st:** slip stitch || **dc:** double crochet || **hdc:** half double crochet



## Head:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

- 1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).
- 2 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).
- 3 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).
- 4 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc \* repeat 5 more times (30 sts).
- 5 round:** \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (36 sts).
- 6 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts).
- 7 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (48 sts).
- 8 round:** 1 sc in each sc (48 sts).
- 9 round:** \* 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 4 sc \* repeat 5 more times (54 sts).
- 10 round:** 1 sc in each sc (54 sts).
- 11 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (60 sts).
- 12 to 16 round:** 1 sc in each sc (60 sts, 5 rounds in total).
- 17 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (54 sts).
- 18 round:** 1 sc in each sc (54 sts).
- 19 round:** \* 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 4 sc \* repeat 5 more times (48 sts).
- 20 round:** 1 sc in each sc (48 sts).
- 21 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts).
- 22 round:** 1 sc in each sc (42 sts).

· Now you must do and sew the eyes and nose. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation below and page 5.

- 23 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 3 sc \* repeat 5 more times (36 sts).
- 24 round:** 1 sc in each sc (36 sts).
- 25 round:** \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (30 sts).
- 26 round:** 1 sc in each sc (30 sts).
- 27 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 2 sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).
- 28 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

· Now you must do and sew the hair and ears. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation on pages 5 & 6.

· To make the mouth, with black yarn, do one diagonal stitch (2 sts in length), on round 24. You can place the mouth a little to the right to make her expression more fun.

· Make the small cheeks with rouge.

- 29 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (12 sts).
- 30 round:** \* sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (6 sts).

· Stuff the Head. Now using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close. Fasten off.

## Eye: (x2)

· With DK white yarn and 3mm crochet hook create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

- 1 round:** 2 sc in next 2 sc, 2 ch, skip next sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc (10 sts).
- 2 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat one more time, 3 sc in next 2-ch space, \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (18 sts). Join with sl st in first sc of this round. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Put the eyes on the head. Place them centered, between rounds 15 and 20 of the head, with the 2ch space of each eye facing the inside of the head and sew their outer edges. For your reference these parts have a distance of 2 sts between them. Fasten off.

· Now put the amigurumi safety eyes in 2ch space of each “white eye”.

· To make the eyelashes, with black thread make several stitches around the outer edge of the eye, between rounds 15 and 16. Then do 3 little stitches on the outer edge of each eye, next to the previous black stitches. Make the first stitch straight (1 st in length) and the others a little slanted (2 sts in length).





### Nose:

· These parts are worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 to 2 round:** 1 sc in each sc (6 sts, 2 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· The nose does not need to be stuffed. Sew the nose on the head. Place it centered, between rounds 19 and 21. Fasten off.

### Hair:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With dark red yarn and 5mm crochet hook create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

· Work with the back loop all this part.

**1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

**2 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

**3 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).

**4 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc \* repeat 5 more times (30 sts).

**5 round:** \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

**6 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts).

**7 to 14 round:** 1 sc in each sc (42 sts, 8 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

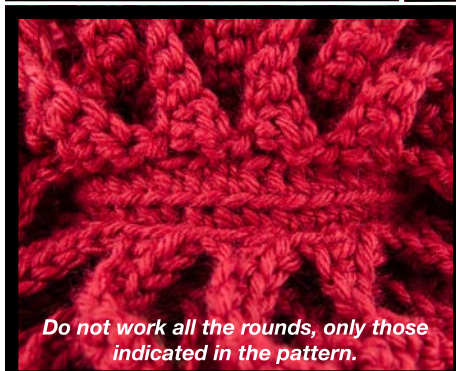
### Strands of hair:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. Pull up a loop of a new dark red yarn on front loop of Magic Ring of the hair and do:

**1 row:** \* 16 ch, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 13 ch, 1 hdc in next ch, skip next 2 sc, 1 sl st in next sc \* repeat around (*2 strands*). Fasten off.

· Repeat this process (*the row 1*) working only on the following rounds of the hair: 1 (*4 strands*), 2 (*6 strands*), 3 (*8 strands*), 4 (*10 strands*), 6 (*14 strands*), 8 (*14 strands*), 10 (*14 strands*) and 12 (*14 strands*).

· Sew the hair on the head, making stitches around the edge of the hair. Place it tilted so that the lower edge is at Round 11 at the centre front and Round 25 at centre back. Fasten off.





### Ear: (x2)

· These parts are worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

**2 to 3 round:** 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 2 rounds in total).

**4 round:** \* sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (6 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Sew the edges of each ear following the instructions on page 2, in section “Generic Processes: Sew Edges“.

· Then sew the ears on both sides of the head, left and right, between rounds 16 and 19. Fasten off.



### Witch Hat:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With black yarn and 5mm crochet hook create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (9 sts).

**2 round:** 1 sc in each sc (9 sts).

**3 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (12 sts).

**4 round:** 1 sc in each sc (12 sts).

**5 round:** \* 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (15 sts).

**6 round:** 1 sc in each sc (15 sts).

**7 round:** \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (18 sts).

**8 round:** 1 sc in each sc (18 sts).

**9 round:** \* 1 sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (21 sts).

**10 round:** 1 sc in each sc (21 sts).

**11 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (24 sts).

**12 round:** 1 sc in each sc (24 sts).

**13 round:** \* 1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (27 sts).

**14 round:** 1 sc in each sc (27 sts).

**15 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (30 sts).

**16 round:** 1 sc in each sc (30 sts).

**17 round:** \* 1 sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (33 sts).

**18 round:** 1 sc in each sc (33 sts).

**19 round:** \* 1 sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (36 sts).

**20 round:** 1 sc in each sc (36 sts).

**21 round:** \* 1 sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts).

**22 round:** 1 sc in each sc (42 sts).

**23 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (48 sts).

**24 round:** 1 sc in each sc (48 sts).

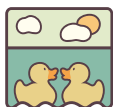
**25 round:** \* 1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (54 sts).

**26 round:** 1 sc in each sc (54 sts).

**27 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (60 sts).

**28 round:** 1 sc in each sc (60 sts).

**29 round:** \* 1 sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (66 sts).



- 30 to 31 round:** Change to Fuchsia yarn. 1 sc in each sc (66 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**32 to 33 round:** Change to Black yarn. 1 sc in each sc (66 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**34 round:** \* 1 sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (72 sts).  
**35 round:** \* 1 sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 6 sc \* repeat 5 more times (78 sts).  
**36 round:** \* 1 sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (84 sts).  
**37 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 7 sc \* repeat 5 more times (90 sts).  
**38 round:** \* 1 sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (96 sts).  
**39 round:** \* 1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 8 sc \* repeat 5 more times (102 sts). Fasten off.

### Buckle:

· With orange yarn create a Magic Ring with 2 ch, \* 7 dc + 2 ch + 4 dc + 2 ch \* repeat one more time. Join with sl st in first dc of Magic Ring (22 sts). Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

· Sew the buckle on the witch hat, between rounds 29 and 32. Fasten off.

### Arms: (x2)

· This part is worked in joined rounds. You must join with sl st each round and start the next round with 1 ch. For this part, use the color guide below. Create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

- 1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).  
**2 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).  
**3 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).  
**4 to 7 round:** 1 sc in each sc (24 sts, 4 rounds in total).  
**8 round:** \* 1 sc in next 10 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (22 sts).  
**9 to 10 round:** 1 sc in each sc (22 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**11 round:** \* 1 sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (20 sts).  
**12 to 13 round:** 1 sc in each sc (20 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**14 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (18 sts).  
**15 to 16 round:** 1 sc in each sc (18 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**17 round:** \* 1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (16 sts).  
**18 to 19 round:** 1 sc in each sc (16 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**20 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (14 sts).  
**21 to 22 round:** 1 sc in each sc (14 sts, 2 rounds in total).  
**23 round:** \* 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (12 sts).  
**24 to 26 round:** 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 3 rounds in total). Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Color Guide:

- Beige Magic Ring and Rounds 1 to 6.
  - Orange Rounds 7 and 8.
  - Fuchsia Rounds 9 and 10.
  - Orange Rounds 11 and 12.
  - Fuchsia Rounds 13 and 14.
  - Orange Rounds 15 and 16.
  - Fuchsia Rounds 17 and 18.
  - Orange Rounds 19 and 20.
  - Fuchsia Rounds 21 and 22.
  - Orange Rounds 23 and 24.
  - Fuchsia Rounds 25 and 26.
- Pull up a loop of a new orange yarn between rounds 6 and 7, do 1 surface sl st in each sc (24 sts).
- Stuff the arms and sew the edges following the instructions on page 2, in section “Generic Processes: Sew Edges”.





### Leg: (x2)

· You must stuff these parts little by little as you crochet them, making the process easier.

· This part is worked in joined rounds. You must join with sl st each round and start the next round with 1 ch. For this part, use the color guide below. Create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

**2 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

**3 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times. Join with sl st in first sc of this round (24 sts).

**4 round:** *Work with the back loop only this round.* 1 sc in next 24 sc (24 sts).

**5 round:** 1 sc in each sc (24 sts). Leave a long tail of black yarn.

**6 round:** \* 1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (27 sts).

**7 to 9 round:** 1 sc in each sc (27 sts, 3 rounds in total). Fasten off, leaving a long tail on first leg. Don't fasten off the second leg.

· Pull up a loop of a new black yarn between rounds 5 and 6 of the leg, do 1 surface sl st in each sc (27 sts).

### Joining the 2 Legs and Starting the Body:

· Take the second leg and do:

**10 round:** 1 sc in next 5 sc (*figure 1*), (take the first leg) 1 sc in the 22nd sc of first leg (*figure 2 & 3*), 1 sc in next 26 sc of first leg (*figure 4*), 1 sc in next 22 sc of second leg (*figure 5 & 6*) (54 sts).

**11 to 12 round:** 1 sc in each sc (*figure 7 & 8*) (54 sts, 2 rounds in total).

· Now you must take the yarn of the first leg with your needle, and do several stitches at the joint between the first and second leg. Fasten off. (*figure 9 & 10*)

**13 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (60 sts).

**14 to 19 round:** 1 sc in each sc (60 sts, 6 rounds in total).

**20 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (54 sts).

**21 to 22 round:** 1 sc in each sc (54 sts, 2 rounds in total).

**23 round:** *Work with the back loop only this round.* 1 sc in each sc (54 sts).

**24 round:** \* 1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (48 sts).

**25 to 26 round:** 1 sc in each sc (48 sts, 2 rounds in total).

**27 round:** \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts).

**28 to 29 round:** 1 sc in each sc (42 sts, 2 rounds in total).

**30 round:** \* 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

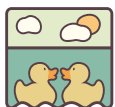
**31 to 34 round:** 1 sc in each sc (36 sts, 4 rounds in total).

**35 round:** \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (30 sts).

**36 round:** \* 1 sc in next 1 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 2 sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later (*figure 11 & 12*).

### Color Guide:

- Black Magic Ring and Rounds 1 to 5.
- Orange Rounds 6 and 7.
- Fuchsia Rounds 8 and 9.
- Orange Rounds 10 and 11.
- Fuchsia Rounds 12 and 13.
- Orange Rounds 14 and 15.
- Fuchsia Rounds 16 and 17.
- Orange Rounds 18 and 19.
- Fuchsia Rounds 20 and 21.
- Black Rounds 22 and 36.



### Skirt:

· Pull up a loop of a new black yarn on front loop of round 22 of the body and do:

**1 round:** \* 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (60 sts).

**2 to 8 round:** 1 sc in each sc (60 sts, 7 rounds in total).

**9 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, skip next 2 sc, 3 dc + picot + 3 dc in next sc, skip next 2 sc \* repeat 9 more times (70 sts, *not including picot*). Fasten off.

### Finishing the Witch Amigurumi:

· Place the witch hat on the head. Optionally you can make some stitches to secure it.

· Sew the head on the body.

· With black yarn, sew the arms on both sides of the body, right and left, between rounds 32 and 33.

· Fasten off all yarns.
